# Assembly and Installation Instructions

The AlleyOop Round Trampoline Weather Cover is designed to protect your investment from UV rays that harm the jumping mat and pad, and to keep debris off of your trampoline. Make sure to brush debris off of the weather cover so that the venting mesh near the center can act as a drain for moisture.

The following pages contain diagrams, pictures, and written instructions for installing your Trampoline Weather Cover.

Familiarize yourself with the Assembly and Installation Instructions before beginning installation.

# Windy Conditions

It is possible for the trampoline to be blown about by a high wind, with or without a weather cover installed. If you anticipate high winds, see trampoline manufacturer's recommendations for windy conditions.

# **Cold Weather Protection**

The Trampoline Weather Cover is designed for year-round outdoor use. However, in climates of cold weather, we recommend the Trampoline Weather Cover be removed if snow or ice is anticipated. To remove the Trampoline Weather Cover, simply follow the instructions for installing it in reverse order.

**WARNING:** Do not jump on the trampoline with the weather cover installed.

# Before you begin installing your Weather Cover, please check to see what kind of frame pad you have installed on your trampoline.




Bottom of net, inbetween poles, secures under middle of pad and around trampoline rail



1) Lay weather cover on trampoline. Align cutouts of weather cover with legs of trampoline. If they do not line up, rotate cutouts to an adjacent leg.




2) Detach *inner, shorter* Velcro slits at each of the 16 locations on the weather cover. Slide each section under the safety enclosure net, and around the button bungees. Then, from outside the trampoline, reattach all Velcro slits.

**Note:** The net should remain connected to the bed of the trampoline at 16 points (16 button bungees). These connections should align with the Velcro slits. Readjust any net connections on the net itself that do not line up with the Velcro slits.




**3)** Secure the weather cover around the inside each trampoline leg piece using the buckles, as shown.

To remove the weather cover, follow the Installation Instructions in reverse order.




1) Lay weather cover on trampoline. Align cutouts of weather cover with legs of trampoline. If they do not line up, rotate cutouts to an adjacent leg.




**2)** Detach *outer, longer* Velcro slits at each of the 16 locations on the weather cover. Slide each section under the safety enclosure net, and around the bungee T-anchors. Then, from outside the trampoline, reattach all Velcro slits.

**Note:** The net should remain connected to the bed of the trampoline at 16 points (16 bungee T-anchors). These connections should align with the Velcro slits. Readjust any net connections on the net itself that do not line up with the Velcro slits.




**3)** Secure the weather cover around the inside each trampoline leg piece using the buckles, as shown.

Your Trampoline Weather Cover is now installed! *Keep center drain mesh clear of debris.* To remove the weather cover, follow the Installation Instructions in reverse order.




1) Lay weather cover on trampoline. Align cutouts of weather cover with legs of trampoline. If they do not line up, rotate cutouts to an adjacent leg.



**2)** It is recommended that you remove the short straps with buckles that hold the bottom of the net down between the poles, then reinstall the short straps after the weather cover is in place. Short straps will be installed through the grommets in the weather cover. See your JumpSport Elite manual for how to secure the straps.


#### Assembly and Installation Instructions-Type C Installation

WARNING: All short straps with buckles along bottom of net, MUST be reinstalled and secured before trampoline is used again.



Your Trampoline Weather Cover is now installed! Keep center drain mesh clear of debris. To remove the weather cover, follow the Installation Instructions in reverse order.

**What is covered by this warranty?** This warranty covers any defects in materials or workmanship on all of the components of the AlleyOop Round Trampoline Weather Cover, and is extended exclusively to the original retail purchaser.

**How long does this coverage last?** Warranty coverage for each component begins from the original date of purchase and lasts for 90 days.

**What will AlleyOop Sports do?** If you return the defective part to AlleyOop Sports, as instructed below, AlleyOop Sports will either repair or replace such part, at AlleyOop Sports' discretion, and return it to you.

What is not covered by this warranty? This warranty does not cover expenses of on-site labor, shipping costs, travel, assembly or disassembly, or other charges associated with the repair or replacement of covered components. This warranty also does not cover any problem that is caused by abuse, misuse, commercial or public use, ordinary wear and tear, weathering, acts of God (such as wind and lightning), failure to follow directions, improper installation, or improper maintenance. - 2) Send the part(s) to the designated Service Center, along with a copy of your original sales receipt and a brief written description of the problem, including how it occurred. You must pay freight and insurance to return the part to AlleyOop Sports. At AlleyOop Sports' sole discretion, we may ask you to send photographs in addition to or in lieu of returning the part.
- 3) After inspecting the returned part(s), AlleyOop Sports will make a final determination whether the part is covered by this warranty. We reserve the right to examine photographs or physical evidence concerning parts claimed to be defective prior to making a final determination concerning the claim. A repaired or replacement part will be returned to you. (Shipping charges may apply.) Please allow 3 to 4 weeks for delivery.
